Pupils at The Westminster School have many complex needs and may at times have more difficulty managing their behaviour than other pupils. In these cases an individual plan with both pupil, parent/carer and shared with school staff will be drawn up.

Exclusions

In certain circumstance it may be necessary to exclude a pupil for serious incidents. A member of SLT will make contact with parents/carers to discuss the issue and to make an appointment for a post exclusion meeting.

Anti-Bully Policy - see our Anti-bullying Policy

The Westminster school operates a no tolerance approach to bullying at all times. It is a whole school approach which aims to remove the causes of bullying. Bullying incidents (including Cyber-bullying and the use of social media) are dealt with by a Senior Member of Staff.
